Privacy Statement

For the Dordrechts Museum it is of the highest importance to handle personal information of visitors to our website with care. The Dordrechts Museum website strives to protect your privacy as much as possible.

By indicating that you wish to receive information you are agreeing to receiving information on our activities and products via email. You will at all times be offered the option of unsubscribing to these emails. Dordrechts Museum does not collect names, addresses, telephone numbers or other personal data unless they have been given voluntarily while visiting our website. All data pertaining to relevant personal information will be registered in our database following the new Data Protection Act. When using our website we automatically save certain information. This can be information about your URL location, which browser you are using and in which geographical area you are. We use this information in the course of normal use and management of our website and are permitted to release this information as a whole. By grouping this data the information it contains cannot be traced to an individual user.

We are not interested in data which gives information about the identity of a visitor to our website. However Dordrechts Museum is interested in information that gives insight into the use of the site, such as: how many visitors do we have? What are the peak times and which pages are visited the most? With this knowledge we can improve the usability of the website.

Cookie policy

Google Analytics

Dordrechts Museum uses cookies to keep track of web statistics. Tracking cookies

On this website we are also permitted to use tracking cookies. These cookies enable targeted advertisements and help us measure the effectiveness of a campaign. For this purpose we ask your permission via the cookie banner.
